something bad happens to me online.

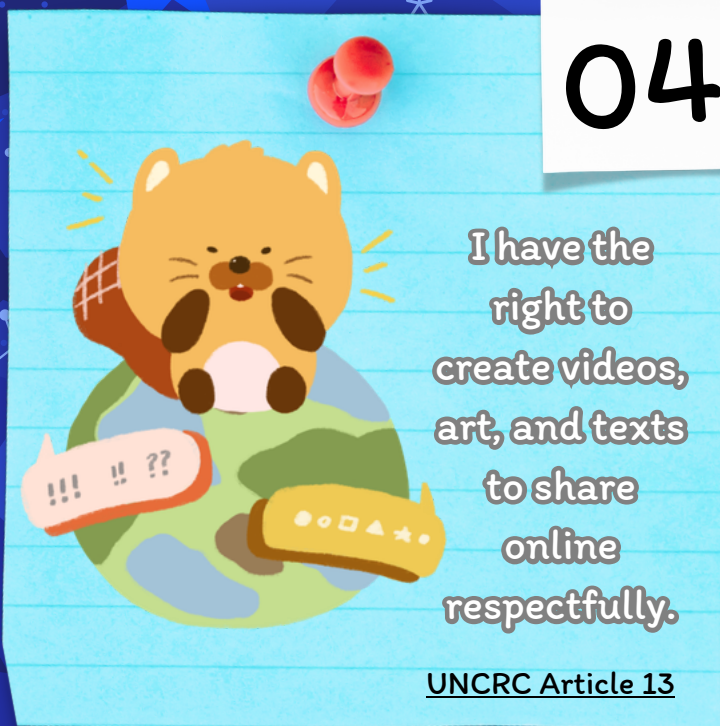
If I am bullied, tricked, or scared, adults should

I have a right to know if information online is true, if a
video is an ad, or if a photo has been changed.
I deserve information that keeps me happy and healthy.

Right to Equal Access

UNCRC Article 2



I have the right to use the
internet to learn and connect,
no matter who I am.

I should not be left offline or treated differently because
of my gender, where I live, or how much money my
family has. The digital world is for everyone.
